- ABOUT THE GALA:** The 9th annual *A Night of Hope Gala* is a black-tie fundraising dinner to benefit the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Capitol Chapter. We anticipate over 600 guests at the National Building Museum for cocktails, a seated dinner, silent and live auctions and live entertainment. Our 2008 event raised over \$1.1 million for diabetes research and we hope to surpass that amount this year.
